We also accept current magazines, movies, music cd's, and audio books.

The branches can accept 3 bags or 3 boxes at a time. Calvert Library in Prince Frederick can accept larger quantities.

Due to space restrictions, we will accept encyclopedias published in the last 10 years and textbooks published in the last 5 years.

To donate items, please bring them into the building during library hours, and ask a librarian where to leave them. A book cart can be made available.

A donation receipt form is available upon request. The library does not keep a copy nor place a value on donated materials.

After reviewing donated items, librarians will decide whether to add the items to the library collection, to sell at the Book Sale, or to recycle.
